Primarily a resource for music educators and performers, this research guide includes library resources in the form of bibliographies of concert music from composers from throughout the African Diaspora, as well as some of the sheet music holdings and score anthologies of such music held at the Auburn Avenue Research Library.

Resources include call numbers, for patrons to easily inquire and obtain resources. Auburn Avenue Research Library maintains non-circulating policies of its collection; however, patrons are able to utilize materials in-house.

AARL Finding Aids

Finding aids are descriptive inventories that provide information on both the content and historical context of collections of archives and manuscripts. The Auburn Avenue Research Library Finding Aids presented by the <u>Digital Library of Georgia</u> describe approximately 100 unique research collections, including personal papers, organizational records, oral histories, photographs, and audio-visual resources. The archive also includes a sheet music collection which includes rare and out of print scores.
